



At Lee Health, donated blood goes to help save the lives of patients at your community-owned hospitals: Lee Memorial Hospital, HealthPark Medical Center, Golisano Children's Hospital of SW Florida, Gulf Coast Medical Center and Cape Coral Hospital. In addition to the five hospitals, our blood center also services the Level II Trauma Center at Lee Memorial Hospital and the Regional Cancer Center at the Sanctuary.

To donate blood you must:

- Weigh at least 115 lbs.
- Be at least 17 years old, 16 years old with parental consent
- Be in general good health – no colds, flu, sore throat, etc.
- Photo ID, with DOB, if new donor

Every time you donate blood, you will receive vital health checks at no cost. You will be checked for the following:

- Pulse Rate
- Blood Pressure
- Body Temperature
- Hemoglobin (iron level)
- Blood Type
- Cholesterol level

Just one single pint of blood can help save the lives of several people. Your donation can be separated into its different components: the platelets may go to a child with leukemia, the plasma to a patient with a clotting problem and the red blood cells to an accident victim.
